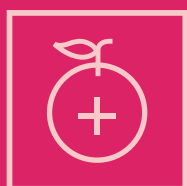

## GETTING STARTED ONLINE

Here's how to get the most out of your **Pink Hero** online fundraising page.

### Make your page your own

Make your **Pink Hero** page stand out from the crowd with a photo of yourself and some information about why you're taking action towards Zero Deaths from breast cancer. Your story is special and so are you. The more people know about you, the more money you'll raise for life-saving breast cancer research.

### Set a goal and go for it

The fundraising goal you set is entirely your choice, you can make it higher or lower any time you like. Whatever goal you set, remember the only way to achieve it is to share it! Kickstart your fundraising by making the first donation to your page.

### Spread the word

Once you've added some personality to your **Pink Hero** fundraising page, spread the word by sharing it with everyone. Remember to ask friends and family to share your **Pink Hero** fundraising page through their own social media and workplaces. The more that people know about you and your **Pink Hero** fundraising page, the more donations you'll get.

### Download your online materials

Log into your **Pink Hero** page to download plenty of helpful fundraising materials. You'll find posters, tips, games, social posts, and more!

# THINKING BIGGER

The most successful Pink Heroes are the ones that make the most of their fundraising events. They make them fun, engaging and interactive for everyone – so people keep coming back year after year.

## Wondering how it's done?

Here are some great ways to take your event plans to the next level.



### Assign roles

Share the load by asking your best friends or closest family members to help you plan. You can assign fun, specific roles like; Chief Promoter, Sponsorship Guru, Logistics Mastermind, and more. Your event will be more fun to organise as a team – and by assigning individual tasks, you'll make sure each element is planned to perfection.



### Make it themed

Australians love a dress up, so why not consider a theme. You can make your theme the feature of the event with a catwalk toward the best dressed king or queen. You can also raise more money by penalising those who don't dress up with a gold coin donation.



### Get crafty

Saving costs on your event means more money for research. Make some origami table decorations. Create pretty donation boxes decorating empty jars. Or, borrow a chalkboard for signage at your event. The more personal, the better.



### Get social

Create a buzz about your event before it begins by sharing your story and **Pink Hero** fundraising page on social media.

Some more creative ways to build excitement include 'update' emails, email signatures, text messages, and social media groups. Don't forget to download the resources on your **Pink Hero** fundraising page, and tag us and hashtag on social media too **@nbcfaus #NBCFPinkHero**.



### Increase your goal

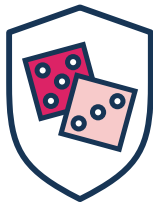
Each time you reach your goal, celebrate and then increase it. You can easily change your goal by logging into your online **Pink Hero** fundraising page.



### Keep your fundraiser breast cancer friendly

If you're serving up food, try to make sure that your menu includes a balance of fresh fruit and veg. We know everyone likes a drink now and again – just make sure your fundraiser includes a responsible service of alcohol and provide non-alcoholic beverage options too. Brush up on NBCF's ethical guidelines for more information.





### Add some games

Bring out your inner child and add some games to your event to keep everyone laughing.

Childhood classics like bobbing for apples, the three legged race, or musical chairs are always a hit. Charge a gold coin donation for every game entry to help you reach your goal.



### Organise a raffle

An easy way to add fun to your event is with a raffle. Reach out to local businesses to get prizes donated. You can set the price yourself and make sure you include a bargain price for anyone who buys a few tickets (eg. 1 ticket for \$5 or 3 tickets for \$10).



### Ask your community to dollar match

Ask your workplace or your favourite local business to match your donations – this way, every \$1 you raise becomes \$2! You'll be surprised by how many businesses might be willing to help. And if you need a special dollar matching letter from us – just ask.

# WRAP IT UP!

When your fundraiser is over, **celebrate** and tell everyone what you have achieved.

## SAY THANK YOU

Nothing shows appreciation like a heartfelt **thank you**. Thank everyone who donated, volunteered or gave prizes. You can say thanks on social media, in cards or use the certificates from your downloadable resources.

## CELEBRATE YOUR SUCCESS

Let everyone know how much you raised **together**. Share photos with some extra thank you messages to sponsors and be proud. You're helping stop deaths from breast cancer.

## DONATE ANY CASH COLLECTED

Don't forget to bank any cash collected in person. You can send it straight to NBCF:

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## Do you have any materials to help me with my event?

Yes we do, just log into your fundraising page to find all of your downloadable materials including posters, games ideas, and more.

## Can I change the date of my event?

If you change your event date, you'll need a new Authority to Fundraise with your new date printed on it. Just drop us an email or call us.

## Can I give receipts to people who donate?

Yes you can. Encourage people to donate to your online **Pink Hero** fundraising page and they'll automatically receive a receipt. If you require a receipt book, just drop us an email or call us.

## How can I get prizes?

You can reach out to local businesses for prizes using your Authority to Fundraise. You can scan, print off or email this around to let everyone know that you are an approved NBCF fundraiser.

## Can I use the NBCF logo?

Sure! The NBCF logo is available upon request, just drop us an email or call us.

## Can I change my fundraising goal or URL?

You can change your goal or URL at any time. Just log into your online **Pink Hero** fundraising page to make these changes.
