[About the National Breast Cancer Foundation and breast cancer]

The funds raised from today's event will be donated directly to the National Breast Cancer Foundation (NBCF).

NBCF is Australia's leading not-for-profit organisation funding world-class breast cancer research.

NBCF has an ambitious vision - Zero Deaths from breast cancer. has

Since their inception in 1994, they have invested over \$200 million into more than 600 word-class research projects

- In this time, the death rate from breast cancer in Australia has reduced by over 40%.
- This decline is in large part due to the research that's been done in prevention, early detection as well as new and better treatments.
- While this is progress to be proud of, diagnoses of breast cancer continue to increase at a rate greater than population growth,
- o In the last 10 years, breast cancer diagnoses in Australia have increased by 21%
- oand numbers of deaths from breast cancer continue to rise.
- This year alone:
- o More than 21,000 Australians will be told "you have breast cancer" and,
- Sadly 3,300 people in Australia will die from breast cancer.
- The impact of this deadly disease is far reaching. Permeating through families, friendship groups, workplaces, and communities.
- NBCF's vision to end deaths from this disease is more pressing than ever.





• And therefore the Pink Ribbon Breakfast has never been more important.

[About Pink Horizon Research Strategy]

- At NBCF they're determined to create a better tomorrow. They know research matters, and it is central and critical to improving breast cancer outcomes. Through their grant schemes, they fund the very best breast cancer research in Australia from fundamental biological research to clinical research via an open national, competitive and rigorous peer review process. This means they award grants by order of merit to the finest breast cancer research in alignment with their vision of Zero Deaths from breast cancer.
- In late 2023, they developed a new five-year research strategy to guide their strategic research investments.
- Through their *Pink Horizon Research Strategy*, they fund breast cancer research aligned to four core research objectives.
- Research focused on how to:
- o **Prevent** breast cancer through precision prevention
- o **Detect** breast cancer as early as possible and before it progresses
- o Stop the progression and recurrence of breast cancer, and
- o **Treat** hard-to-treat and metastatic breast cancers.
- By supporting research in these areas, NBCF believe they can drive progress towards ending deaths from breast cancer.

[About NBCF's Collaborative Research Accelerator Grant]

- NBCF has recently made a transformative step toward achieving their vision.
- In August 2025, NBCF announced a landmark \$25 million investment the largest in their history – awarding their first Collaborative Research Accelerator Grant to an exceptional local and international collaboration led the Garvan Institute of Medical Research who will drive a research program called 'AllClear'
- The Collaborative Research Accelerator Grant brings together the brightest minds in breast cancer research from across Australia and around the world to tackle breast cancer's most urgent and unsolved challenges.
- The AllClear program is focused on stopping breast cancer recurrence, with the long-term goal to halve deaths from breast cancer.
- The AllClear team is a collaboration of nearly 60 researchers across seven leading research institutes and organisations and 11 hospitals across NSW and places the voices of people with lived experience at the heart of its work.





- This is more than funding it is:
- A strategic catalyst for change
- A powerful demonstration of Australia's research leadership, and
- o A vital step toward saving lives
- If successful, this groundbreaking research could not only halve deaths from breast cancer, but it could also unlock insights that may transform outcomes across other cancer types as well.
