Did you know?

Breast cancer is a complex disease made up of many different subtypes. To prevent it from growing and spreading (progression) or coming back after treatment (recurrence), we need to understand the causes behind these events, even when they happen years or decades after diagnosis.



MEET THE RESEARCHER:

The \$25 million NBCF Collaborative Research Accelerator (CRA) Grant was awarded in 2025 to a powerful local and international collaboration led by the Garvan Institute of Medical Research.
