## RAFFLE TICKETS



## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Organise a prize or prizes for your raffle. These could be purchased by you, or donated by others.
- 2. Decide how much you will sell your tickets for.

  This could be \$2, \$5, \$10 or any other amount you think is reasonable. Change this value in the editable fields on the tickets below.
- 3. Decide how many tickets you will need and print them out. We have numbered the first few pages, but there are extra un-numbered tickets on the last page if you need more. Using scissors, cut out each ticket along the navy dotted lines.
- **4. Sell tickets in your raffle.** This can be done in the lead up to your event, on the day, or both.
- 5. When someone buys a ticket, write their name and phone number on their ticket/s, then cut or tear on the pink dashed line. The coloured half is for the ticket holder so they know their ticket number. Keep the half with their details to add to the draw.
- **6. Draw the winning ticket/s.** Fold all the kept ticket halves so you can't see who they belong to, and place them into a bucket or large bowl. Without looking, pick a ticket to select the winner of each prize.
