What year was the first Pink Ribbon used as a breast cancer awareness symbol?

1992

Most people think the pink ribbon has always been the symbol for breast cancer awareness, but the original ribbon was actually peach. The pink ribbon wasn't introduced until 1992 and has since become one of the world's most recognised awareness symbols.

Which Monopoly property space is coloured pink in the traditional version?

Northumberland Avenue

The pink set is one of the most underrated groups in Monopoly. It sits just after Jail, making it a relatively common landing spot, especially as players leave Jail in the middle of the game. The full pink set is St. Charles Place, States Avenue and Virginia Avenue.

Vincent van Gogh

Van Gogh painted more than a dozen blossoming orchard scenes in just a few weeks during spring 1888. He considered Pink Peach Trees one of the most successful paintings in the series.

Western Australia

Lake Hillier is so pink that even when its water is collected in a bottle, it stays pink. It's located on Middle Island, the largest island in the Recherche Archipelago off the coast of Western Australia.

Pink Fairy Armadillo

The Pink Fairy Armadillo is the world's smallest armadillo, growing to only about 10-15 cm long. It lives in Argentina and spends most of its life underground. Its distinctive pink shell helps regulate its body temperature.

Why are flamingos pink?

Because of their diet

Flamingos aren't actually born pink. They hatch with grey or white feathers and gradually turn pink from eating foods rich in carotenoids, such as algae and tiny crustaceans. The more carotenoids they eat, the brighter their pink colour becomes.

What is the first name of the singer P!nk?

Alecia

P!nk's real name is Alecia Beth Moore. She adopted the stage name 'P!nk' as a teenager, and the exclamation mark later became a distinctive part of her brand.

Which famous London newspaper is printed on pink paper?

Financial Times

The Financial Times has been printed on distinctive salmon-pink paper since 1893. The colour was originally chosen as a way to stand out from competitors and has since become one of the most recognisable newspaper brands in the world.
